











WOOLGOOLGA SWIMMING POOL COMPLEX UPGRADE

Council recently endorsed the redevelopment of the Woolgoolga Swimming Pool Complex. The complex contains a 25m outdoor public pool with separate toddler pool and water slide operating from September to April each year.

Complete Urban have been engaged by Coffs Harbour City Council for the design and documentation of 2 new aquatic centres at Sawtell and Woolgoolga. Both facilities are at the end of their useful life, require extensive maintenance and do not provide a high level of user amenity. Following community consultation, Council decided to build 2 new facilities comprising a 25m FINA compliant pool with terraces seating, access ramp, a learn to swim pool and a 200m2 zero depth splash pad. An amenities building and plant building is also provided.

The Woolgoolga facility is located close to the ocean on a sloping site and required care fuel planning so the facility took advantage of the outlook whilst providing universal access throughout.
